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## Case Management Services

**Court Diversion Services** are available to anyone 12 and over who finds themselves involved with the court system because of a mental health crisis.

**Court Rent Supplement** program provides rent supplements for clients to access safe and affordable housing.

### **Getting Appropriate Personal and Professional Support (GAPPS)**

services reach out to clients in the community who are not connected to traditional services, are homeless and have serious mental health and addictions issues.

**Homelessness Initiative Program (HIP II)** provides rent supplements for clients to access safe and affordable housing.

**Housing First** is a minimal barrier housing service specifically designed for individuals living with concurrent mental illness, addiction and other challenges.

**Transitional Rehabilitation Housing Program (TRHP)** provides intensive case management services to forensic clients, promoting recovery and helping them to successfully navigate the transition into community life.
