

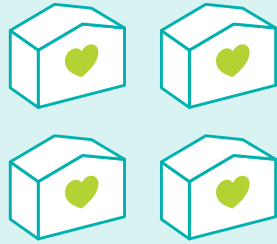

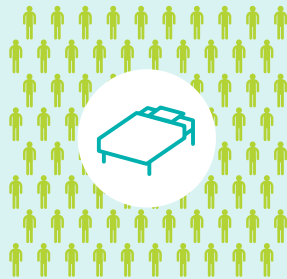
4 agencies saw
